

Monthly Mission NOTES FROM COMMUNITY & GLOBAL MISSIONS BOARD

Bethlehem's January monthly mission is **House of Hope**, an integrated residential and non-residential treatment service facility for adults for ongoing recovery from substance use and mental health disorders. The House of Hope, Inc. serves 26 county regions using a holistic philosophy and habilitative approach to recovery. They serve men's and women's programs through individual therapy sessions, trauma-based therapy, and medication management. Their goal is to provide client-centered treatment, reduce treatment barriers through scholarship funds, and support recovery through peer support specialists in addition to living skills development.

We hope that Bethlehem members will support this very important service to our community friends who are struggling with mental health and substance use issues during the month of January. Thank you for your generosity and prayers.

Council Corner


Here are the "highlights" of the Bethlehem Council meeting

held on December 21. Meeting minutes with details are posted at www.blcmankato.org and are also available in the church office notebook. Visit with Council members with questions and concerns! We welcome your conversation & feedback! Financial Report: November 30 balance was a deficit of -\$12,256 that increased from -\$9,500 on October 31. General fund giving is at 89% of expected income. Members are encouraged to fulfill 2021 pledges and make other gifts to balance budget by December 31. 2022 stewardship pledges received from 152 members thus far with +\$43,596 over 2021. Follow-up mailing reminder going to unpledged members for financial support of Bethlehem's mission and ministry. We need you to make a difference. Financial Review **Committee:** Frank Larsen approved for new 3-year term to conduct annual review of BLC financial practices. God's Global Barnyard Monthly Mission: \$12,100 received thus far in meeting goal. Donations still encouraged online or in office to make a difference. Sunday Worship Time Survey: 80 responses received with support for shifting worship time 30 minutes later to 9:30 a.m. effective Sunday, February 6. Forums & LIGHT to start at 10:45 a.m. Laurie Rossow Celebration: Laurie's 12 years of music leadership & service as Director of Music & Worship and Adult Choir to be recognized at 10 a.m. on Sunday, January 9. Join us! New Music Leadership: Charlie Leftridge approved as new long-term music and choir director effective January 1 after successful interim work since August 1. New Members Approved: Richard & Karen Bouquet returned to area/applied to rejoin BLC. **COVID Update:** Removal of sanctuary pew seating cards completed. Welcome cards for BLC visitors to be updated & reinstated to pew holders. No other changes made in BLC COVID masking & other policies given Omicron virus spread. Family Faith Formation Director Sabbatical: Planning is under way by Personnel Committee for 6-week May/June 2022 sabbatical leave. Application created & to be completed by December 31. Details to be worked out by committee with Anna during January-April 2022. Strategic **Planning Update:** Listening sessions with BLC members held. Key insights and preliminary goals developed for further discussion and decision by Council and congregation. Next event is the Day of Remembering on January 9 at 10:30 a.m. Plan to attend to share your memories and history of Bethlehem. Call Committee Update: Ministry Site Profile to be developed starting in January based upon information from strategic planning listening sessions & Day of Remembering. The profile will be send to synods and candidates as introduction to Bethlehem. Congregation will also be surveyed regarding desired skills and priority areas for next pastor. This will be shared with synod for prospective candidates. Flags in the Sanctuary: Moderator still to be secured for congregational forum planned for January 23 at 10:15 a.m. to discuss & discern the issue of display of flags in the sanctuary. Council members making contacts with suggested individuals. Capital <u>Campaign</u>: Stewardship Committee charged with reviewing professional capital campaign proposals for mortgage and other projects and make recommendation to Council. Next Council Meeting: Tuesday, January 18.
